The show is telling the stories of Indigenous histories, communities, and aspirations.

Access Communications was awarded Canada's Best Diversity Employer award in 2019 and we continue to celebrate the diversity within our workforce, with staff and others celebrating occasions like the Regina Mosaic Cultural Festival, National Indigenous Peoples Day, Diwali and more.

This simple mandate is the inspiration for our registered charity, the Access Communications Children's Fund. It's how we do our part to help youth in Saskatchewan.

Since its launch in 1992, our charity supports organizations whose programs focus on children at risk or in need. In 2019, our Children's Fund hit an important milestone: We have now donated over \$2 MILLION to non-profits and charities across the province.






